Holcombe began his career as an officer in the U.S. Army, where he served as company commander in the 1116th Signal Battalion and was awarded both the Douglas MacArthur Leadership Award and Most Outstanding Officer of the Year. Holcombe graduated from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point with a bachelor of science degree, finishing first in his class in Computer Science. He earned a master of business administration degree in Information Systems from Chaminade University in Honolulu, and a master of science degree in Computer Science from George Washington University.
